Patrick Scully: *Leaves of Grass* — *Uncut*

In celebration of Walt Whitman's 197th birthday, longtime Minneapolis performer/impresario **Patrick Scully** channels the character of New York's nineteenth-century poet-spirit, already celebrated recently by choreographer Paul Taylor. Drawing upon video work by award-winning artist Nancy Mason Hauser, Scully's 75-minute solo *Leaves of Grass — Uncut* incarnates Whitman and is augmented by images of eighteen men, naked and clothed, dancing together, bringing into view issues about male-male relationships and the forces that seek to deny them. Appreciate the bard anew through Scully's amalgam of art, history, literature, opera, and, of course, thoughtful, considered movement. Both Whitman and Scully are major figures; they contain multitudes.
